Activity:

Shaving foam art

Area of learning:

Creative Development and Communication, Language & Literacy

What you need:

Shaving foam
Food colouring
Paper

What to do:

Spray shaving foam onto a large flat surface; add a few drops of food colouring to the shaving foam and mix the colours together using a wooden spoon.

Encourage the children to draw patterns and shapes in the foam using their fingers. Take a piece of paper and place one side of the paper onto the coloured foam, press down on the paper to transfer the colours onto the paper. Remove the paper from the foam and leave on a flat surface to dry for 2 minutes, remove any excess foam from the paper.

Allow the paper to fully dry and enjoy your artwork!
