Activity:

Making play dough

Area of learning:

Creative Development, Personal, Social & Emotional, Problem Solving, Reasoning & Numeracy and Physical Development.

What you need:

2 cups of flour

1 cup of salt

1 cup of water

1 tbsp. cooking oil

(Optional; food colouring, glitter, coco powder)

How to make Play Dough:

The children are to mix the flour and the salt together and then gradually stir in the water. Knead the dough together adding small drops of extra water if necessary to make a smooth but not sticky dough.

Once the dough has come together turn it out onto a flat surface and continue to knead it for around 10 minutes by which time the dough should be warm, soft and flexible.
